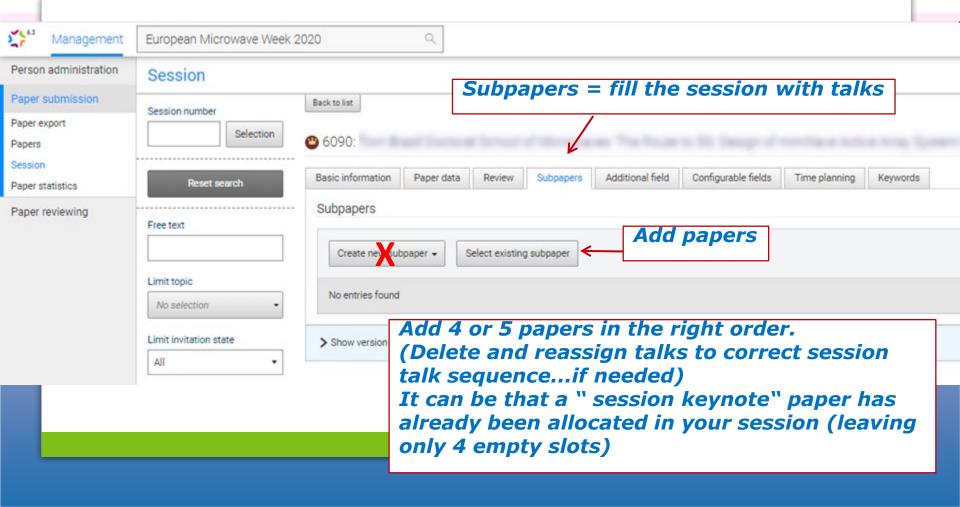


Build Sessions: Add Title



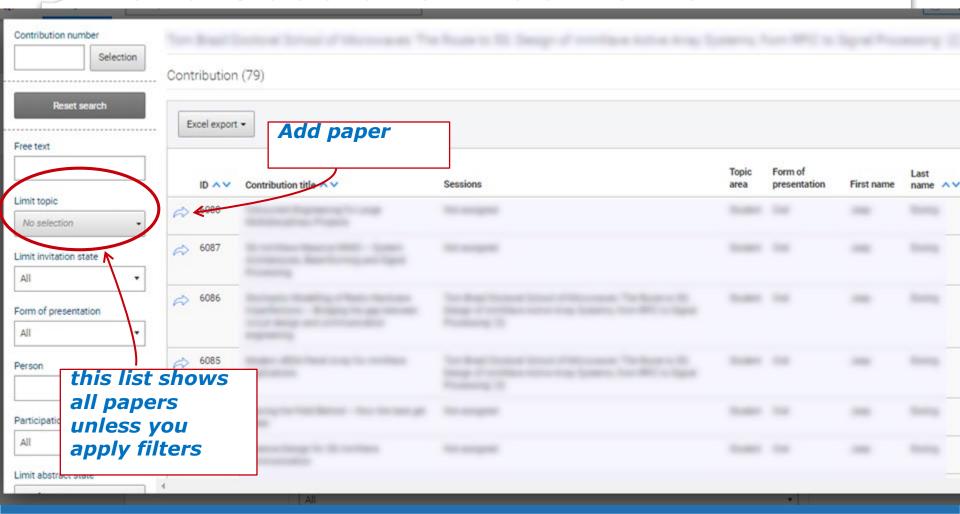


Build Sessions: Add Talks



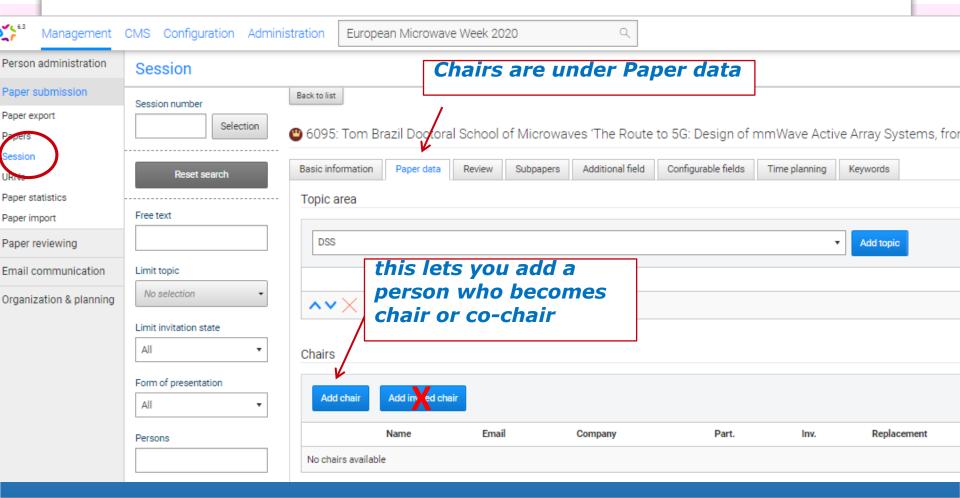
